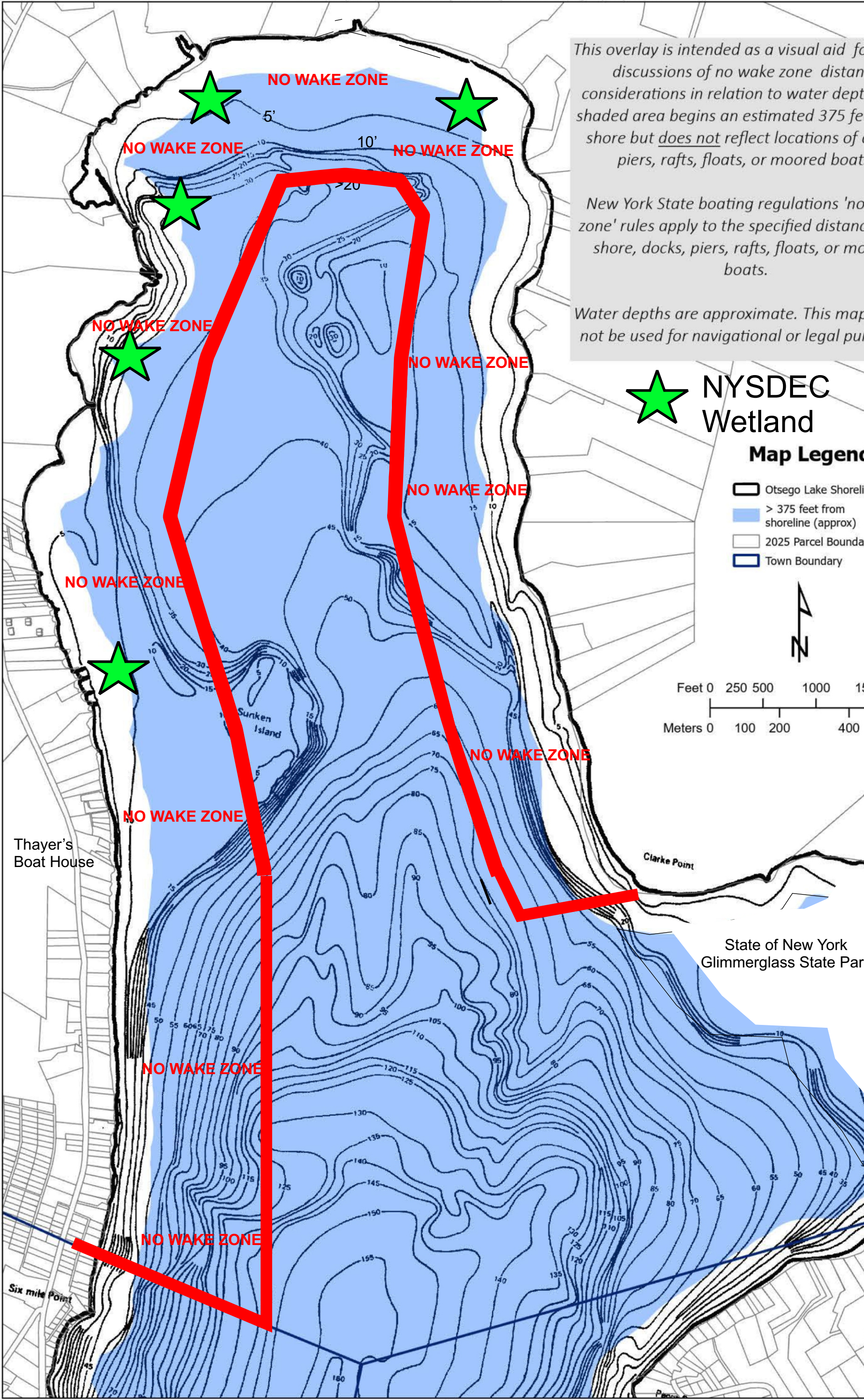

This overlay is intended as a visual aid for discussions of no wake zone distance considerations in relation to water depth. The shaded area begins an estimated 375 feet from shore but does not reflect locations of piers, rafts, floats, or moored boats.

New York State boating regulations 'no wake zone' rules apply to the specified distance from shore, docks, piers, rafts, floats, or moored boats.

Water depths are approximate. This map should not be used for navigational or legal purposes.
